## Independent Skill

### **"I CAN ...Pick out my own clothes!"**

Have your child pick out their clothing for the day. Work on their choices being school and weather appropriate. If this is a struggle start by giving them the choice between 2 appropriate options and work towards giving them the tools to make the decision on their own.

## Co-Operative Behaviors

### **"I CAN...Play a Game!"**

Each week play a game with your child, or together as a family. Learn new games, play old favorites, or make up your own!

## Motor Skills

### **"I CAN...Rake the leaves!"**

Have your child help you rake the leaves. This will help them build their large muscle skills. Make the activity FUN! How big can the pile get... Jump in the pile to see how deep it is!

## Mathematics & Science

### **"I CAN...Sort & Count Leaves!"**

Go on a Nature Walk to collect leaves when you get home have your child count them, discover differences in them (color, size, type) put them in groups or sequence them in rows (big to little)

## Problem Solving

### **"I CAN...Figure out what is coming next!"**

While reading to your child...Before turning the page, ask "What's Next?"  
See if your child can come up with a logical outcome for the plot of the story.

## Language and Literacy Development

### **"I CAN...Learn a new song!"**

Find a new song that you and your child can learn together!  
BONUS: have your child share the song with the class.

## Social and Emotional Skills

### **"I CAN...Be thankful!"**

Help your child make a collage with all the things they are thankful for, people or things. You can draw pictures or use photos, cut out magazines.
